



STATE OF EMERGENCY DECLARATION

WHEREAS, The Town of Green Mountain Falls, Colorado, suffered serious damages to its infrastructure (roads, bridges) as a result of flooding and other impacts related to the heavy precipitation which occurred Monday, July 23, 2018 and to a lesser extent thereafter throughout the week;

And

WHEREAS, the magnitude of the incident and the response and recovery costs far exceed normal operational resources available to the Town of Green Mountain Falls Government;


And

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2-203(1) of the Town of Green Mountain Falls, the Mayor has been conferred with the unilateral authority under such circumstances to declare a local emergency;

NOW THEREFORE, in accordance with the aforementioned legal authority as Mayor I hereby do declare a formal state of emergency throughout the jurisdictional boundaries of the Town.
