# 1. Call to Order/Roll Call/Pledge of Allegiance

Mayor Dixon called the regular meeting to order at 7:01pm. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. All Trustees were present.

## 4. Reports

Marshal Goings reported that there were 63 calls of service for the month of August, which was up from 55 the prior month.

Kelley Hakes Public Works Supervisor reported that the trash volume was still going strong due to the high amount of tourism. Kelley Hakes reported how he hired Adam King-Peters part time for public works. That there have been some machinery issues with the grader and the skid steer.

Town Manager Caleb Patterson reported on starting the paperwork to get reimbursed by PPRTA for the road work done this year. The stilling basin is still waiting for the water to be hooked up. The RTA grant has reopened, and we will apply for this grant for engineering on the bridge and will also be using HDR through a technical assistance grant that we were awarded to apply for the Bridge Improvement Program (BIP) to apply for engineering. By working with both grants it is ensured we get engineering for the bridge. The new accountant is working on the 2024 audit and with the workload they are at a higher rate.

Ann Esch 6830 Colorado St. reported how she attended a zoom meeting with the Water Quality Management Committee since she represents the Town of Green Mountain Falls. She reported that it provided great information and especially on Regulation 43.

# 6a) Ordinance 2025-05 AVIS Speed Control

Marshal Goings reported that META Traffic had reached out to him regarding speeding and how they have equipment that can help small towns. Marshal Goings reported on how he had conducted a speed survey around the Town and on Highway 24 for the month prior. The results from that survey did come in and it showed how much speeding was occurring and how dangerous it was. META Traffic presented how their company works with small towns. An Ordinance was written regarding using this Speed Control system. Trustee Moralez motioned to approve, seconded by Mayor Dixon. Motion carried.

## 6b) 2025 Creek Week Proclamation.

A presentation was presented about the Fountain Creek Watershed management, the history of creek week and how to get involved.
