Guidelines for dropping off slash

- No early / late drop-off of slash. Enter Joyland ONLY on designated chipping days during the hours of 8:30 AM – 4 PM.
- FOLLOW TRAFFIC PATTERN (see map below)
- Slash segments should be less than 5 feet long and less than 6 inches in diameter
- No cottonwoods or willows
- No construction or building materials; treated lumber, fence posts or signs
- No shrubs, root wads, stumps, dirt or rocks
- No loose or bagged pine needles, grass clippings, trash, weeds, or bags of leaves
