ORDINANCE NO. 2024-01

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE III OF CHAPTER 8 OF THE GREEN MOUNTAIN FALLS MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO PARKING REGULATIONS IN THE TOWN

WHEREAS, the Town desires to amend sections of the Green Mountain Falls Municipal Code (the "Code") to make updates to parking regulations in the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees finds that these amendments are in the best interest of the Town and its citizens.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF GREEN MOUNTAIN FALLS, COLORADO:

- <u>Section 1</u>. Section 8-42 of the Code is amended by the deletion of the following definitions: residential parking permit and one-day visitor permit.
 - <u>Section 2</u>. Sections 8-43, 8-44, and 8-48 of the Code are hereby deleted.
 - <u>Section 3</u>. Section 8-45(a) of the Code is hereby amended to read as follows:
 - (a) It is unlawful for any person to park a vehicle on any public street in an area marked for residential parking.
- Section 4. Section 8-45(c) of the Code is hereby amended by the addition of a subsection (5) to read as follows:
 - (5) A vehicle given express permission by the town or its authorized designee.
- <u>Section 5</u>. <u>Severability</u>. If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Ordinance shall for any reason be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or enforceability of such section, paragraph, clause, or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance, the intent being that the same are severable.
- <u>Section 6</u>. <u>Safety</u>. The Board of Trustees finds that the adoption of this Ordinance is necessary for the protection of health, safety, and welfare of the public.
- Section 7. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon approval and 30 days Public Notice.
