

TOWN OF GREEN MOUNTAIN FALLS ORDINANCE NO. 2025-03 Excavation

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTOIN 7-5 OF THE GREEN MOUNTAIN FALLS MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING WORK ON PUBLIC PROPERTY AND IN RIGHTS-OF-WAY

WHEREAS the Board of Trustees desires to amend Section 7-5 of the Green Mountain Falls Municipal Code to clarify that a permit is required from the Town to perform construction work on public property or in public rights-of-way.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF GREEN MOUNTAIN FALLS, COLORADO:

<u>Section 1</u>. Section 7-5 of the Green Mountain Falls Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

Permit required.

It is unlawful for any person, unless specifically excepted under this Code, to perform any construction work (including without limitation digging, opening, excavating, constructing or replacing sidewalks, or placing fill, gravel, asphalt, or concrete) in, on, over, or under any street, alley, sidewalk, public right-of-way, or public property (whether owned by or under the control of a public entity, including without limitation Town-owned or Town-controlled property) in the Town without first having obtained a permit from the Town.

Such permits shall be kept at the site of the construction activity while the work is in progress and shall be exhibited upon request by any police officer or representative of the Town. A copy of such permit shall also be maintained in the office of the Town of Green Mountain Falls.

- Section 2. Severability. If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Ordinance shall for any reason be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or enforceability of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance, the intent being that the same are severable.
- <u>Section 3</u>. <u>Safety</u>. The Board of Trustees finds that the adoption of this Ordinance is necessary for the protection of health, safety and welfare of the public.
- Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective 30 days after publication.
